## A Man after God's own heart (Acts 13:16-23)

"I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.(Acts 13;22) Who will be a man after God's heart?

<u>David.</u> He loved God deeply. He was always filled with Love of God. The verse of Psalms 23, he confessed "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing" even though he was in a bad situation.
