

Enoch - did not see nor experience death (Hebrews 11:5)

In the bible, there are two persons who entered the kingdom of heaven without death: Enoch and Elijah. We do not know how they were blessed like this but they had something in common: First, they lived in times of unbelief and evil. Second, they did not compromise with sin. It was before the flood and people did extremely wicked acts at the time Enoch lived. Enoch's life pleased God and bible says it that Enoch walked faithfully with God in the book of Genesis. Enoch believed God's existence, God's Word and in obedience in faith for three hundred years.

Invisible world. Everyone/we think that this visible world is all. Enoch was brought to eternal life without death. Enoch shows reality of invisible world - without death. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know—God knows(2 Corin 12:2) "I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far;but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body.(Philippians 1:23-24)**

Life that experience God.Bible says that Enoch is the representation of one who walks with God. What is the life to walk with (be with) God? Enoch lived a very ordinary life without any special achievement. **"When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah.(Genesis 5:21) Enoch walked faithfully with God; then he was no more, because God took him away.(Genesis 5:24)** Faith means living with God; not understandable by knowledge; followed by God with resolution. **"You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder.(James 2:19)**

Life that gives up oneself.We should give ourselves to walk with God faithfully then God will guide us. We should choose one between two conflicts(this world vs eternal world). We could not live perfectly though we decide to rely on God. But God will take care of our past, present and future when we come to him with honesty(Apostle Paul gave up all things what he had when he met Jesus, Abraham left from his country according to God's calling)

Why we can not give up ourselves?

1. We do or have not met God personally yet. Knowing God as knowledge is just faith in knowledge not in practice. We should experience Faith. We should confess like Job in the bible " My ears had heard God but now my eyes have seen" True faith is to hold God's Word
2. Uncertainty of kingdom of heaven. We will not compete in this world if we surely are aware of heaven.

Walking with God - Faithful Life.
